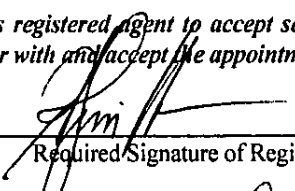

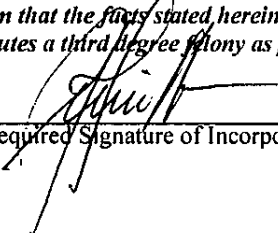

4. Officers may not serve for more than 3 consecutive terms, except for the Founder who will serve as Ex-officio of the association until it exists and other original officers as Board Members.
5. Ex-elected President will automatically be an Honorary (proven loyalty by virtue) Adviser of the association after her term.
6. Honorary advisers may vote, may be assigned committees, may chair committees, and may be re-elected for as long as she did not serve for 3 consecutive years.
