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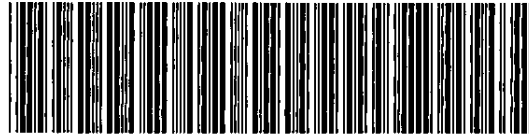

PROPOSED CHARTER OF ST. PETERSBURG LODGE  
THEOSOPHICAL SOCIETY.

CHARTER OF ST. PETERSBURG LODGE THEOSOPHICAL SOCIETY,

an Association, made and entered into by and between Mrs. Rebecca J. Boardman, Dr. Clara Hooper, Mrs. Rebecca B. Ebbecke, Miss E. M. Crowley, Miss Julia P. Danforth, Mrs. Maud H. Kennard, Amy Wilson, Elizabeth Boeck and Eats N. Jrose as members and incorporators.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be ST. PETERSBURG LODGE THEOSOPHICAL SOCIETY and it shall be located at No. 19th Avenue, North, in the City of St. Petersburg, County of Pinellas and State of Florida.

ARTICLE II.

The general nature of the objects of the corporation are: To conduct a Theosophical Society in the said City, County and State; to purchase and sell, own and improve real estate as required for the purposes of the said corporation, or as incidental thereto; to build, erect, rent, lease or otherwise acquire buildings for the use of said corporation; to invest the funds of said corporation in real estate, bonds, stocks, notes, mortgages, or other securities, and make such other investments as the Board of Directors may approve, to provide funds for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation; to own and equip libraries, reading rooms, assembly rooms and houses of worship for the use of said corporation; to employ lecturers and teachers in the propagation of the principles of Theosophy;

And in general the said corporation shall have and exercise the inherent powers prescribed generally for all corporations by

the general law of the State of Florida; and in addition shall exercise the special powers granted to corporations not for profit by the General Statutes of the said State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE III.

The qualifications of members of the said corporation shall be as follows: Believe in God and Brotherhood. And they shall be admitted by action of Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE IV.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.  
(Having existed since February 13th, 1919, as a Branch of the Theosophical Society (International) founded in America November 17th, 1875, New York City.)

#### ARTICLE VI.

The affairs of the said Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, who shall choose from their number a President, one or more Vice Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such officers as the Board of Directors may from time to time choose, in order to carry out the objects of this corporation.

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five or more than twenty members. The number shall be five members until increased by regular action of the members of this corporation.

The Board of Directors shall be elected at the regular

annual meeting of the said corporation, and they shall convene, without notice, immediately after said annual meeting and organize.

#### ARTICLE VII.

Until the first election shall be held under the terms of this charter, all the affairs of this corporation shall be managed by present officers of the St. Petersburg Lodge Theosophical Society, to-wit:

#### ARTICLE VIII.

The By-laws of the said corporation shall be made and rescinded by the members thereof, at the regular annual meeting, or at a special meeting called for the purpose.

#### ARTICLE IX.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the said corporation may at any time subject itself shall be the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars, provided, however, that said indebtedness or liability shall never be greater than two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation.

Article 2.

The said corporation shall be empowered to hold real estate of the amount in value of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars.

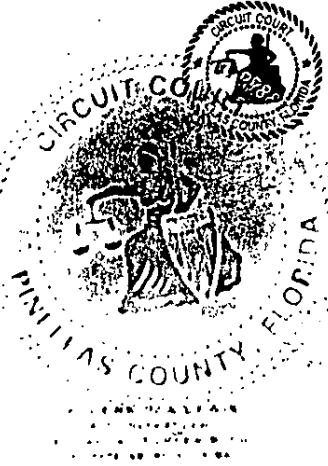
ORDER OF COURT.
