ATTACHMENT "A"

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The purposes of this corporation are exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific, and community developmental reasons, and include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. To aid in the growth and development of families and individuals socially and economically through a sense of social and economic programs.
- 2. The programs will consist of, but shall not be limited to: Child Care, Job Training, Job Placement, Land Acquisition, Housing, Employment, Literacy, Counseling, Temporary Shelter, Teenage Pregnancy, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, AIDS Awareness and Prevention, Elderly Care and other programs to aid those in need.
- 3. To raise the economic, educational and social levels of the residents of Leon County Florida, with particular focus upon members of the surrounding community who reside in the Southern regions of the County, who are substantially unemployed, underemployed, or whose income is below federal poverty guidelines.
- 4. To promote community interest and concern for the problems of the above said residents to the end that (a) educational and economic opportunities may be expanded; and (b) sickness, poverty, crime, and environmental degradation may be lessened.
- 5. To expand the opportunities available to the above said residents and groups to own, manage, and operate businesses in economically depressed areas.
- 6. To expand opportunities available to said residents and groups to obtain adequate low-cost housing accommodations by constructing, rehabilitating, and providing decent, safe and sanitary housing in Leon County for persons and families of low-income who otherwise would not be able to find or afford a suitable place to live. It is the intent of this corporation to provide such housing through rehabilitation of existing substandard buildings and construction of new facilities in the place of uninhabitable structures or

- vacant sites for the purpose of combating the deterioration of the community and contributing to its physical improvement.
- 7. To aid, support, and assist by gifts, contributions, or other means of aid through an alliance with other corporations, community chests, funds and foundations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes, no part of the net earnings will benefit any private shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of the activities of which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- 8. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or obtaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, associations, trusts, institutions, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.
- 9. All of the foregoing purposes shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such a manner that the Corporation will qualify as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
