The purposes of this corporation are exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific, and community developmental reasons, and include, but are not limited to the following:

1. To aid in the growth and development of families and individuals, socially and economically through a sense of social and economic programs.
2. The programs will consist of, but shall not be limited to: Child Care, Job Training, Job Placement, Land Acquisition, Housing, Employment, Literacy, Counseling, Temporary Shelter, Teenage Pregnancy, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, AIDS Awareness and Prevention, Elderly Care and other programs to aid those in need.
3. To raise the economic, educational and social levels of the residents of Leon County Florida, with particular focus upon members of the surrounding community who reside in the Southern regions of the County, who are substantially unemployed, underemployed, or whose income is below federal poverty guidelines.
4. To promote community interest and concern for the problems of the above said residents to the end that (a) educational and economic opportunities may be expanded; and (b) sickness, poverty, crime, and environmental degradation may be lessened.
5. To expand the opportunities available to the above said residents and groups to own, manage, and operate businesses in economically depressed areas.
6. To expand opportunities available to said residents and groups to obtain adequate low-cost housing accommodations by constructing, rehabilitating, and providing decent, safe and sanitary housing in Leon County for persons and families of low-income who otherwise would not be able to find or afford a suitable place to live.
