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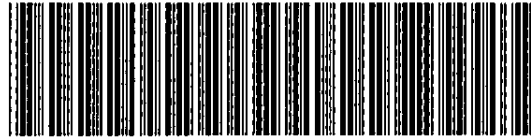

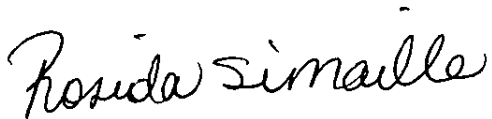

Articles Of Incorporation Of Foundation Hope For Haitian Children, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 1

The name of the corporation is: **Foundation Hope For Haitian Children, Inc.**

Article 2

The principle place of business of this corporation is 3910 North Highland Avenue Tampa, Florida 33603

Article 3

The corporation is organized as a relief organization exclusively for charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) including, but not limited to, for such purposes, the establishing and maintaining of humanitarian aid, **the realizing of social activities aiming to develop the children and the educating of them in a manner consistent with the requirements of Holy Scripture**, the maintaining of training activities in the United States and any foreign country, and any other lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit and not specifically prohibited to corporations under laws of the State of Florida.

Article 4

The method of election of directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation. The corporation shall have a minimum of three directors.

Article 5

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, employees, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article 3.

Article 6

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue

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Article 7

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 8

The corporation shall have a racially nondiscriminatory policy and shall not discriminate against directors, employees, members, applicants, and others on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Article 9

The qualifications, rights, privileges, duties, and classifications, of members of the corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation.

Article 10

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is: 3910 North Highland Avenue Tampa, Florida 33603 and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at the initial registered office is: Mrs. Rosida Simaille

Article 11

The name of incorporator of the corporation is: Mrs. Rosida Simaille and the address of the incorporator is 3910 North Highland Avenue Tampa, Florida 33603

Article 12

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except that the corporation shall not carry any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 13

The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.
