

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SWEDISH-AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF FLORIDA (FT. LAUDERDALE-PALM BEACH) INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a non profit Corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the Corporation is SWEDISH-AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF FLORIDA (FT. LAUDERDALE-PALM BEACH) INC., (hereinafter "Corporation").

ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

The Corporation shall be operated exclusively for pleasure, recreation, and other similar nonprofitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended (the "Code"). The specific purpose of this Corporation is to promote trade and commerce between the nations of Sweden and the United States, and more particularly the State of Florida. The Corporation is intended to qualify as, and exempt from, federal taxation under Section 501(c)(6) of the Code, and is not organized for profit and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE 3 - PROHIBITIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Second hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
