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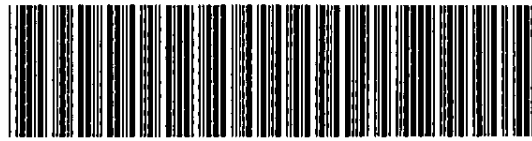

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BELIEVE BEYOND INC.
A NON PROFIT COPORATION**

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming Incorporated under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended, of the Laws of the State of Florida applicable to corporations not-for-profit, and respectfully petition the Secretary of State for approval of such Incorporation under the following proposed Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE – NAME

The name of the corporation, hereinafter called the Corporation, shall be: BELEIVE BEYOUND INC. Its Principal Office Is located at: 1100 E Rose Street Lakeland, FL 33801949

ARTICLE TWO – DURATION

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE – DIRECTORS

The name and address of the initial directors who shall hold office until their Successors is four, may thereafter be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE FOUR – REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered agent of the corporations is 1916 Cristal Grove Drive Lakeland, FL 33801 and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at that address is Horace Bailey

ARTICLE FIVE – PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is founded are:

- (b) To organize a non-profit corporation and associate together persons, associates and corporations in order to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific and educational purposes described, permitted and limited

in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 401(a) of the 1954 Internal Revenue Code, hereinafter referred to as the Code. For the purposes and powers as set forth herein these Articles of Incorporation, references to the provisions of the Code shall be deemed to include Statutes which succeed such provisions and all appropriate regulations and rulings of the Internal Revenue Service pursuant thereto; Including but not limited to, the following activities:

- (1) To advance the general good and welfare of youth in our community and advance their education.
- (2) To provide early intervention and prevention services through the mentoring relationship to at-risk youth, youthful offenders, of educational failure, teen pregnancy, truancy and juvenile delinquency and their families at special locations including community centers, schools, and in the community.
- (2) To provide valuable tutoring, academic support, values and character building, programming, counseling, and confidence-building mentoring programs to prevent and reduce the participation of juveniles in delinquent activities and to provide education and social services to address the social and developmental needs of juveniles.
- (3) We purpose to reach the youth of our community through activities aimed at health, fitness, education, life skills, and social enrichment. We also propose to create a single entry point to all the various services available to young people through a series of partnerships with local agencies and community groups.
- (4) Improving parenting skills through specially designed mentoring for parents can improve how the parent and child interact. The improvement in this relationship may reduce the risk of child behavior problems and subsequent antisocial behavior. This program is targeted toward parents and addresses the psychological needs of the parents and the stresses and social supports that can either help or hinder the parent's ability to adapt to the needs of the child.
- (5) To take, accept, hold and acquire by bequest device, gift, purchase, loan or lease, any property, real, personal or mixed, whether tangible or Intangible, without limitation as to the kind, amount or value;

(6) To sell, convey, lease or make loans, grants or pledges of any property or any interest therein or proceeds there from, and to invest and reinvest the principal thereof and receipts there from, if any;

(7) To borrow money upon and pledge or mortgage any such property for the purpose for which it is organized, and to issue notes, bonds or other forms of indebtedness to secure any of its obligations;

(8) To acquire, and pay for in cash or promissory note*, the goodwill, rights, assets and property, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligation or liabilities of any person, firm, corporation or association;

(9) To carry on any of the aforesaid activities or purposes either directly, or as an agent for or with other persons, associations or corporations;

ARTICLE SIX – POWERS

This Corporation shall be operated and governed by a Board of Directors.

The By-Laws may provide for the extent and limits of these powers, duties, terms and privileges, and further, shall provide for the manner of appointment, qualification or election and other matters relating thereto, subject to restrictions herein, including, the number of Directors may be provided in the By-Laws but shall at all times be not less than three (3).

ARTICLE SEVEN– LIMITATION

1. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statement(s), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code,

3. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable

compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

ARTICLE EIGHT – DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to or one or more charitable, education, scientific or exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state, or local government for a public purpose.

ARTICLE NINE – AMENDMENTS

The Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation may be amended, altered or revised when such resolution is duly certified by the Secretary of the corporation by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors and filed with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE TEN – FISCAL YEAR

The Fiscal year of the Corporation shall be from January to December of each Year.

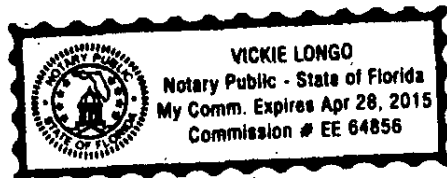


