AMENDMENT ATTACHMENT

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE - (Add)

The purpose for which the Tallahassee Harambee Arts & Cultural Heritage Council, Inc. is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V:

(Amend)

Section 1: The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at 2314 Atapha The initial registered agent of the Nene, Tallahassee, Florida 32301-5858. Corporation shall be Beverly A. Barber at the same address.

(Add) Section 2: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

(Add)

Section 3: In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501 ©(3) and 170©(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
