ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is TRAVELLING MEDICAL MISSIONERS CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE III.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation TRAVELLING MEDICAL MISSIONERS (TMM) WAS ESTABLISHED IN 2011 TO PROVIDE HEALTH PROMOTION AND DISEASE PREVENTION SERVICES THROUGH HEALTH SCREENINGS, COMMUNITY AWARENESS, AND HEALTH TEACHINGS TO UNDERSERVED POPULATIONS ACROSS THE GLOBE.
