The undersigned, acting as sole incorporator, adopts these Articles of Incorporation and forms a not-for-profit corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act"), pursuant to Section 617.0202, Florida Statutes (Not-for-Profit) and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Corporate Name

ARTICLE II Principal Address
