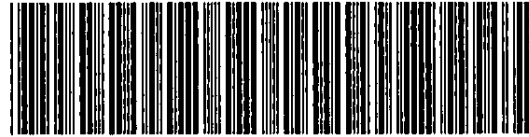



ARTICLE VIII Purpose Clause and Dissolution of Assets Provision

1. Purpose Clause. The Pet Professional Guild (PPG) is devoted to improving the business conditions for dog training and pet care professionals and businesses committed to using 'force-free' techniques, methods and processes. All members share the common business interest of educating the pet owning public in the differences and advantages of 'force-free' training and pet care methods over other systems. The PPG will represent its membership by:
 - a. Educating the public on the differences and advantages of 'force-free' training and pet care methods over other systems.
 - b. Establish higher business standards and methods to include uniformity and cooperation within the 'force-free' community.
 - c. Establish business integrity within the 'force-free' community
 - d. Operating and Publishing ***Barks From The Guild***, the trade magazine for the 'force-free' dog training and pet care community.
 - e. Encourage the use of equipment, training aid and services that are designed and used based on the concepts of 'force-free' training and care.
 - f. Appearing before, submitting statements to or sending communications to members of local council or other governing bodies with respect to legislation or proposed legislation concerning animals, especially pets.
 - g. Communicating information between members and the organization with respect to local and national legislation of direct interest to the organization and its members.
2. Dissolution of Assets.
 - a. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
