These articles of incorporation are signed by the incorporators for the interpretation of Florida Statutes, Chapter STATE forming a corporation not for profit under the provisions of Florida Statutes, Chapter STATE as follows.

ARTICLE I. - NAME

The name of this corporation is Friends of Bobby Jones Golf Club, Inc.

ARTICLE II. - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office and the mailing address of the corporation is 141 Garden Lane, Sarasota Florida 34242.

ARTICLE III. - PURPOSE

The corporation shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes including, but not limited to, the preservation and enhancement of the experience of BOBBY JONES GOLF CLUB, a municipal facility serving the Sarasota, Florida area, through sponsorship of projects, programs and events for individuals, children and families.

- (a) Conducting its affairs, carrying on its operations, and having offices and exercising the powers granted by the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act in any state or in any foreign country;
 - (b) Conducting educational, training, leadership development and mentoring programs;
 - (c) Administering for charitable purposes property donated to the corporation;
- (d) Distributing property for such purposes in accordance with the terms of gifts, bequests or devises to the corporation not inconsistent with its purposes, as set forth in these articles of incorporation, or in accordance with the determination made by the board of trustees pursuant to these articles of incorporation;
- (e) Receiving gifts and bequests and to use the principal and income generated from the investment of the gifts and bequests for the benefit of the corporation, or such other charitable, religious or educational organizations that are described in \$501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and exempt from taxation under \$501(a);
- (f) Reserving the power to modify any restriction or condition on the distribution of funds for any specified charitable purposes or to specified organizations if in the sole judgment of the board of trustees (without the necessity of the approval of any trustee, custodian or agent), such restriction or condition becomes, in effect, unnecessary, incapable of fulfillment, or inconsistent with the charitable need; and
- (g) Engaging in any and all lawful activities necessary or desirable for the accomplishment of any of the above described powers.

ARTICLE IV. - MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have Members. The Members of the Corporation shall be divided into classes as enumerated in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V. - BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of trustees consisting of no less than three trustees. The board of trustees shall be elected or appointed as provided in the Bylaws. The board of trustees shall have the requisite power and authority, which is customarily vested in corporate directors over the business and affairs of the corporation. The initial trustees of this corporation shall be as follows:

ARTICLE VI. - REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The registered office of this corporation shall be 141 Garden Lane, Sarasota, Florida 34242, and the registered agent at such office shall be Shawn Glen Pierson.

ARTICLE VII. - INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator is as follows:

ARTICLE VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Effective Date of the Corporation is 17 March 2013.

ARTICLE IX. - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE X. - COMPENSATION AND ACTIVITIES

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its trustees or officers, or any individual, but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. The corporation shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation to such extent as would result in the loss of the exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles of incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities that are not permitted to be carried on:

- (a) By a corporation exempt from taxation under the Code; or
- (b) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

ARTICLE XI. - INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify the incorporator and any trustee or officer, or any former trustees or officer, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XII. - OFFICERS

The corporation shall be governed by a president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and any other officers that may be established by the bylaws of the corporation. The officers will be elected by the trustees at the annual meeting in accordance with the bylaws.

ARTICLE XIII. - BYLAWS

The bylaws of this corporation shall be made, altered, or rescinded by the board of trustees at any regular or special meeting held in accordance with the bylaws.

ARTICLE XIV. - AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

These articles of incorporation may be amended from time to time by a resolution adopted by a two-thirds vote of the board of trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present; provided, however, that these articles of incorporation shall not be amended to permit the corporation to engage in any activity prohibited in Article VII.

ARTICLE XV. - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation by distributing those assets exclusively for charitable purposes in such manner or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable or scientific purposes as shall, at the time, qualify as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as the board of trustees shall determine. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court that has general jurisdiction for the county in which the principal office of the corporation shall then be located, exclusively for such charitable purposes or such charitable organization or organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code as the court shall select.

ARTICLE XVI. - DEFINITIONS

For purposes of these articles, "charitable purposes" include educational, religious, scientific, public and other purposes, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) of the Code. Any reference in these articles to a section of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall be deemed to include the corresponding provision or provisions of any applicable future Internal Revenue Code.
