ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I, the undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of incorporating and organizing a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act (the "Act"), do hereby execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and certify as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Canines Aiding Military Veterans Organization, Inc.

ARTICLE II **PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation shall be:

3535 Military Trail, Suite 103 Jupiter, FL 33458

ARTICLE III **PURPOSES**

Canines Assisting Military Veterans Organization, Inc. (the "Corporation") is not-1. for-profit and is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code"), including, without limitation, to aid and assist disabled military veterans by providing them with highly trained service dogs, to teach and train disabled military veterans to use service dogs provided to them, to assist disabled military veterans in caring for their service dogs, and to train and foster the training of service dogs for use by disabled military veterans.

No part of the earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director 2. or officer of the Corporation, or to any other person (except that the Corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or on behalf of the Corporation and make other payments and distributions in furtherance of one or more of its purposes), and no director or officer of the Corporation, or any other person shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation. The Corporation shall pay no dividends.

The Corporation shall not participate, directly or indirectly, or intervene in 3. (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The Corporation shall not have the objectives nor engage in activities that would characterize it as an "action organization" as defined in Treasury Regulations.

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4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

5. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors will, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for scientific, educational or charitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall determine.

ARTICLE IV ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be as provided in the Bylaws.
