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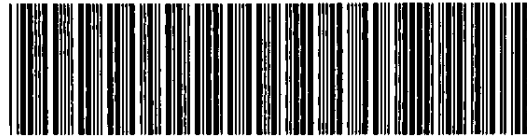

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
FOR
Joseph Project of America, Inc.**

The undersigned Incorporator of these Articles is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a Corporation for non-profit under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

Article I - NAME

The name of the Corporation is **Joseph Project of America, Inc.**, (hereinafter called organization).

Article II - PRINCIPAL BUSINESS

The address of the principal office of the organization is 923 NE 108 Street, Biscayne Park, Florida 33161 and the mailing address is 923 NE 108 Street, Biscayne Park, Florida 33161.

Article III - PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

The **organization** shall engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

Article IV - ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Each person named in these Articles of Incorporation as a member of the initial Board of Directors will hold office until said directors will have been qualified and elected at the first annual meeting of directors, or until said directors earlier resignation, removal from office or death.

Article V - OFFICERS

The initial Directors/Officers of the organization shall be:

5.1: 501(c)(3) Election. The directors/officers of this organization may elect and if elected shall continue such election to be a 501(c)(3) Corporation as permitted within the meaning under Chapter 17.0202 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), unless the directors/officers of the organization unanimously agree otherwise in writing.

5.2: Dissolution of Assets. After this organization has elected to be a 501(c)(3), none of the directors of this organization without the written consent of all the directors of this organization shall take any action, or make any transfer or other disposition of the assets of the organization. Upon dissolution of the organization, the remaining assets must be used exclusively for exempt purposes, such as charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific purposes.

5.3: Other Activities. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities: not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

5.4: Winding Up and Dissolution. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this organization, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and the obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article VI – REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The initial address of the registered office of this organization is 923 NE 108 Street, Biscayne Park, Florida 33161. The name and the address of the registered agent of this organization is Brandon Leno, 923 NE 108 Street, Biscayne Park, Florida 33161.

Article VII – INCORPORATOR

The name and street address of the Incorporator of the organization is Brandon Leno, whose address shall be the same as the principal office of the organization.

Article VIII – DURATION

The organization shall have a perpetual existence.

Article IX – AMENDMENT

The organization reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in the Articles of Incorporation, or in any amendment hereto, or to add any provision to these Articles of Incorporation or to any amendment hereto, in any manner now or hereafter prescribed or permitted by the provisions of any applicable statute of the State of Florida; and all rights conferred upon directors/officers in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment hereto are granted subject to this reservation.

Article x - BYLAWS

The Board of Directors of the organization shall have power to make, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws of the organization, but the affirmative vote of a number of Directors equal to a majority of the number who would constitute a full Board of Director(s) at the time of such action shall be necessary to take any action for the making, alteration, amendment or repeal of the Bylaws.

Article XI - EFFECTIVE DATE

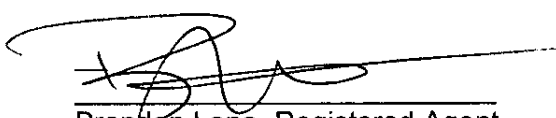
These Articles of Incorporation shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of State, state of Florida.
