(a) Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, scientific and amateur athletic purposes, including, for such purposes the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1968, or the corresponding section of any future its net income shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any of its members, trustees, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes and objects set out herein.

(b) Young adult Independent Party an educational program for ages 18 to 29, venturing in the political arena and supporting peers for office through fundraising. Conventions, platform, campaigns, and votes.

(c) Reentry facilities to coordinate with community partners, state agencies, federal, etc. for the sole purpose creating a citywide, strategic, systematic delivery of resources leading to reduced recidivism increase employment, access to continuing education and the long-term self-sufficiency.

(d) To build, reconstruct, operate and purchase land for schools K-12. (Public) to form policies, rules and regulations, curriculum, accreditations and handbooks. To issue diplomas, transcripts, school transfers, and provide meals. To employ, receive, take by grant, gifts, devise, and bequest or deal in and with real property.

## Supplemental Provision/Purpose Part II

(e) To build or reconstruct facilities to provide multi-service programs for at risk youth such as and not limited to the following:

- (1) Mental Health Early Prevention through behavior assessments and socialization skills.
- (2) Mental Health Family Counseling for ages 15-18
- (3) Amateur Sports (Indoor/Outdoor) Activities for ages 8-18
- (4) Nonmedical Alcohol and Drug Counseling for ages 15-18.
- (5) Juvenile Community Service (up to 18 years old)
- (6) Healthy Eating (parent participation) a weight loss program. Health and Nutrition/Dietitians assessment for ages 4-18.
- (7) Mickey Mouse Clubhouse for ages 4-15 followed by Walt Disney License and sponsorship.
- (8) Alphabet Clubhouse for ages 4-5.
- (9) Spy Kids Clubhouse for ages 8-15
- (10) Music Clubhouse an exercising program for ages 4-18.

(f) Parks and Recreational activities amateur athletic sports for ages 4-18 and community concerts in the park.

(g) To build, reconstruct facilities for theater, musicals, drama, dance, recording, audio and production.

(h) To purchase land for agriculture. To grow natural produce for educational purposes and for Healthy Eating Family Food Program. To have farm animals and stables. To produce healthy meats, fruits and vegetables.

(i) The said corporation is a non-profit faith based organization made up of indigenous people of historical roots from tribes, clans or band, native and American born people. Exercising the organizations rights to use the Fifth and Tenth Amendment for the protection of the people and to use the bill of rights as an alternative. To purchase land, take receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, employ, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, for the operation of said activities.

(j) To make capital contributions or subventions to other not-for-profit corporations. To accept subventions from other persons or any unit of government. To make contracts, give guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by

mortgage or pledges of all or any of its property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

(k) To elect or appoint officers, employees and other agents of the corporation, define their duties, fix their reasonable compensation and the reasonable compensation of directors, and to indemnify corporate personnel, Such compensation shall be commensurate with service preformed. To adopt, amend or repeal by-laws, including emergency by-laws related to the activities of the corporation, the conduct of its affairs, its rights or powers of the rights of its members, directors or officers. To act as beneficiary on all kinds of insurance policies and wills. To receive and receipt for endowments of personal and real property and issue certificates thereof as may appear proper. To make donations, irrespective of corporate benefits for the public welfare or for the community fund, charitable, religious, educational, scientific, or similar purpose, and in time of war or other national emergency in aid thereof.

(k) This said corporation "Victory in New Beginnings" is governed and operated by its affiliate "Victory In New Beginnings International Church of Christ".

(l) The corporation is not limited to its programs, sports or activites and is open to expansion under the purposes discribed as charitable, religious, educational, scientific, and amateur athletic.

### Supplemental Provisions Part III

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509(a) of the international Revenue Code, the Corporation shall distribute its income for said period at such time and in such manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code; and the Corporation shall not (a) engage in any act of self dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, (c) make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or (d) make any taxable expenditure as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Internal Revenue Code Section 501(h), and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office (except provided by Internal Revenue Code Section 501(h)

No director or officer of the corporation shall be liable to the Corporation or to its members for money damages except (1) to the extent that it is proved that such director or officer actually received an improper benefit or profit in money, property or services for the amount of the benefit or profit in money, property or services actually received, or (2) to the intent



that a judgement or other final adjudication adverse to such director or officer has entered in a proceeding based on findings in the proceedings that such director's or officer's action, failure to act, was (a) the result of active and deliberate dishonesty, or (b) internationally wrongful, willful or malicious and, in each such case, was material to the cause adjudicated in the proceedings.
