ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF VARAJAO FOUNDATION, INC.

I

The name of this corporation is Varajao Foundation, Inc.

- A. Varajao Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation") is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, more specifically to provide scholarships, study aid, educational resources and mentoring to children and young adults endowed with exceptional ability, determination and quality so that they may develop their greatness to benefit individuals, communities, society and the world at large. To develop a preparatory educational institution for the development of greatness and leadership. The corporation as part of its charitable purposes may also make distributions to other organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. The assets of the corporation are dedicated to the charitable purpose described in Paragraph 1 above.
- C. Upon dissolution of the corporation, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
