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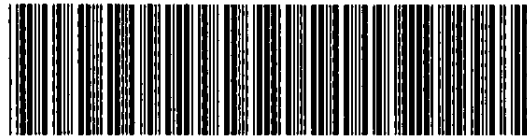

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Thomas M. Cooley Law School Tampa Bay Student Bar Association Corporation

The undersigned incorporators, a natural person 18 years of age or older, in order to form a corporate entity under Florida Statutes, adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be the THOMAS M. COOLEY LAW SCHOOL TAMPA BAY STUDENT BAR ASSOCIATION CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The Thomas M. Cooley Law School Tampa Bay Student Bar Association Corp. is organized for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically to establish a thriving student bar association within the Thomas M. Cooley Law School, Tampa Bay campus. To this end, the Thomas M. Cooley Law School Tampa Bay Student Bar Association Corp. plans to establish, advocate and offer due assistance to fund activities that are deemed to be in the best interest of the entire student body of the Tampa Bay campus; as well as, to be a liaison between the student body and school administration and to cultivate a healthy appreciation of the study of law and enlighten those eager to enter into a career within the legal profession. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

ARTICLE IV

MANNER OF ELECTION

The duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual. Members of the first Board of Directors shall serve until the completion of their term and when their successors are duly elected and qualified, or are removed as provided within the bylaws. Any student who intends to run for office must be currently enrolled at the Thomas M. Cooley Law School, Tampa Bay Campus and must be taking at least three credits and be, as well as maintain, good academic standing.

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP/BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have members that are made up from the student body. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.


