ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be The Greatest Investment Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The principal street address is 1451 Lake Baldwin Lane, Unit B, Orlando, Florida 32814 and the mailing address is P.O. Box 149793, Orlando, Florida 32814.

ARTICLE III.

- The Corporation is organized to provide mentoring, educational services and community outreach to A. at-risk children and families in a structured atmosphere and to facilitate fundraising and collection of in-kind donations in support of this effort.
- B. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or in cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, associations, trusts, institutions, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.
- C. All of the foregoing purposes shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such a manner that the Corporation will qualify as an exempt organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- D. Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and State income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- E. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
- F. The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Directors, Officers or to any individual except as reasonable compensation for purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocable dedicated to charitable and educational purposes, no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- G. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- H. Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporations remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the circuit courts of the district in which the

Corporation's principal office is located, on petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
