ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

STUDENT VILLAGE OF ST. JUDE, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes:

Article J

<u>Name</u>

The name of this corporation is:

STUDENT VILLAGE OF ST. JUDE, INC.

Article II

Principal Office and Mailing Address

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is:

604 Shellcracker Court Tampa, Florida 33613

Article III

Corporate Purposes

- The Corporation is organized as a not-for-profit corporation.
- 2. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax code) (hereinafter the "Code"). In furtherance of such purposes, the specific purposes of the Corporation shall be to establish and maintain a student village and youth center that would provide shelter and spiritual, recreational and educational activities for disadvantaged youths in Daraga, Albay, Philippines.
- 3. This Corporation shall not operate for any purpose other than for its exempt purpose. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws, or any other provision of law, this Corporation shall not carry on any activities which would cause it to fail to qualify, or to fail to continue to qualify, as an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code).
- 4. No part of the net earnings, properties or assets of this Corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any private individual or person, except that this Corporation is authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the Corporation's exempt purposes.
- 5. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; and this Corporation shall not participate or intervene, by publication or distribution of statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on

behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

6. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, after payment of liabilities and obligations of the Corporation, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed for exempt purposes by transfer solely to one or more organizations recognized as exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or to a government unit referred to in Section 170(c)(1) of the Code exclusively for public purposes (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code).

Article TV Board of Directors

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of no fewer than three (3) individuals. The initial members of the Board of Directors shall be Rev. Jude Vera, F. Tobias Tedrowe, and Anthony Caruso. Directors shall hereafter be elected in the manner provided in the Bylaws.
