**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
FOR

A NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION**

We, the undersigned, being competent to contract and desirous of forming a corporation for non-profit purposes under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree and submit the following as and for our Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this corporation shall be **School Bus Repair and Services Inc.** Its principal place of business shall be: 410 N.W. 14th Street, Pompano Beach FL 33060

ARTICLE II – TERMS OF EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless dissolved sooner by operation of law or by corporate resolution.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized as a not-for-profit entity, No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

If reference to federal law in articles of incorporation imposes a limitation that is invalid in your state, you may wish to substitute the following for the last sentence of the preceding paragraph: "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

ARTICLE IX – BYLAWS

The by-laws of the corporation shall be made, altered, and rescinded by a majority vote of the officers/directors at a regular or special meeting of the corporation, subject to all notice and quorum requirements.

ARTICLES X – NONPROFIT TAX-EXEMPT STATUS

Upon the dissolution and winding up of the organization after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, association, or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and which has established its tax-exempt status under that section or corresponding section of a any future federal tax code; or shall be distributed to federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, and which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

ARTICLE XI – AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

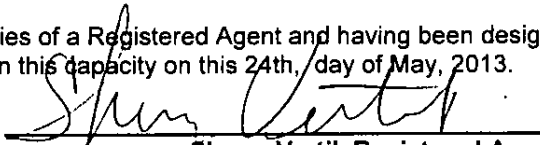

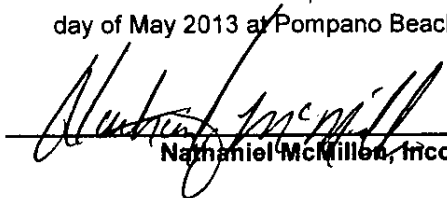

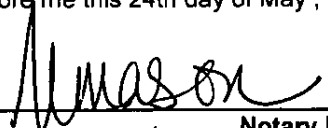
