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

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HOLOCAUST LEARNING AND EDUCATION FUND, INC.

The Articles of Incorporation of Holocaust Learning and Education Fund, Inc., a Florida corporation not for profit organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and formed under document number N13000006479, filed on July 18, 2013, having been amended, are restated to read as follows:

Article 1 Name

The name of this corporation is:

HOLOCAUST LEARNING AND EDUCATION FUND, INC.

Article 2 Corporate Purposes

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The corporation may engage in any activities permitted by law to be engaged in by a corporation not for profit incorporated under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, that is an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The primary purpose of the corporation is to promote the education, learning and awareness of the effects of racism and hatred through broadening public awareness of these tragedies by supporting public education through the support of education and museums. Sponsors will be solicited to achieve the furthering of this program.

The corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activity not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The corporation shall not operate for pecuniary profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure in whole or in part to the benefit of any person having a personal and private interest in the activities of the corporation.

Article 3 Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the registered office of this corporation is 3064 Birkdale Drive, Weston, Florida 33332. The name of the registered agent of this corporation at that address is Craig R. Weiner.

Article 4 Principal Office

Article 6 Board of Directors

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of no fewer than three (3) individuals, all of whom shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided the Corporation's Bylaws.

The qualification, manner of election, duties, terms and other matters relating to the Board of Directors of the corporation shall be provided in the By-Laws of the corporation as amended from time to time in accordance therewith. The initial Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of the following persons who were named in the original Articles of Incorporation of the corporation and who shall remain in office until the next annual meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation and until their respective successors are elected and qualified:

Article 7 Incorporator

Article 8 Tax Exempt Status

The corporation is a not for profit corporation.

It is the express purpose of these Restated Articles of Incorporation to limit the authority, powers, and purposes of the corporation, and to require the corporation to conform to the limitations set forth in the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") with reference to organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the purview of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and nothing herein shall be construed to grant to the corporation any powers or purposes not contemplated and authorized under said Section.

No substantial part of the income or principal of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director or officer of the corporation or any other private individual, in such a fashion as to constitute an application of funds not within the purpose of exempt organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. However, reimbursement for expenditures or the payment of reasonable compensation for services rendered shall not be deemed to be a distribution of income or principal.

No part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at a time and in a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code; the corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code; the corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code; the corporation will not make any investments in a manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the code; and the corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945 of the Code.

Article 9

Disposition of Assets on Dissolution

Unless otherwise prescribed by law, upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities and obligations of the corporation, shall transfer all of the corporation's remaining assets to one (1) or more organizations, as determined by the Board of Directors, that are organized, operated, and qualify as an organization or organizations described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 10

Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article 11

No Members

The corporation shall not have any members. Any action or vote required or permitted by the Act or any other law, rule or regulation shall be by action or vote of the Board of Directors of the corporation.

Article 12

By-Laws

The Board of Directors of the corporation may adopt such by-laws, not inconsistent with these Restated Articles of Incorporation, as they deem proper for the regulation and management of the affairs of the corporation, and the By-Laws may thereafter be altered, amended, or repealed from time to time by a vote of majority of the Directors in attendance at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors at which a quorum is present.

Article 13

Non-Discriminatory Policy

The corporation will make its services, programs, and benefits available to all persons, regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or handicap.

Article 14

Amendment of Articles

These articles may be amended in the manner provided by statute at the time of the amendment, provided, however, that no such amendment shall be made or effective unless a resolution approving same shall have been duly adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board of Directors of the corporation then in office.

There are no members entitled to vote on these Restated Articles of Incorporation. The President of the corporation adopted these Restated Articles of Incorporation on July 26, 2013.
