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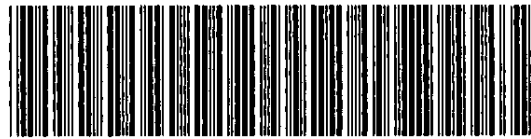



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

(A Florida Not-For-Profit)

Article I. Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Transformation International Fellowship, Inc.

Article II. Principal Office




