ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

BANGLADESHI-AMERICAN CHARITIES OF FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida not-for profit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1: CORPORATE NAME: The name of this corporation is **BANGLADESHI-AMERICAN CHARITIES OF FLORIDA, INC.**

ARTICLE 2: PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The street address of the initial principal office and the initial mailing address of this corporation is 1595 NE 135th Street, Apt. 404, North Miami, FL 33161.

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE: The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized and shall be operated are exclusively for educational and charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Without limiting the generality of the forgoing, this corporation is organized and shall be operated as a relief organization to provide financial and other assistance of various types to those in need of such assistance, and to provide cultural educational programs. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or directors, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation or other organization exempt from federal income tax pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation or other organization, contributions to which are deductible pursuant to section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 4: CORPORATE POWERS: Subject to the provisions of ARTICLE 3, above, of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall have all powers permitted to be exercised by not for profit corporations by law.

ARTICLE 5: DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION: Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining after payment of all liabilities shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed

of shall be disposed of by order of a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of this Corporation is then located, in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article 5.

ARTICLE 6: MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS: This corporation shall have the number of directors, which shall never be lower than three (3), and shall elect directors in the manner set forth in the Bylaws of this corporation.
