ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMMUNITY WELLNESS & HEALTH COOPERTIVE, A FLORIDA CORPORATION

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be desirable and in the best interests of this Corporation and its shareholders that it be incorporated pursuant to the Florida Non Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617; now, therefore, be it:

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of the original Articles of Incorporation for such corporation be attached hereto and that the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation be hereby adopted as follows:

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a Florida corporation under the Florida Non Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation;

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is COMMUNITY WELLNESS & HEALTH COOPERATIVE, CORP.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence. The corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The corporation is organized in order to provide Federal health exchange navigation and to guide people through the new health care laws.

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There shall be three members of the initial board of directors of the Corporation. The manner in which directors are elected or appointed will be as provided in the bylaws of the corporation.
