# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CHARLES PERKINS MINISTRIES, INC. (A CORPORATION NOT-FOR-PROFIT)

I, the undersigned, being a natural person, hereby establish a corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended, of the Laws of the State of Florida applicable to corporations not-for-profit and respectfully petition the Secretary of State for approval of such incorporation under the following proposed Articles of Incorporation.

# ARTICLES 1 - NAME

The name of this corporation is, hereinsfler called "corporation," shall be CHARLES PERKINS MINISTRIES, INC.

# ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

Section 1:

The purpose for which the Corporation is founded are:

- (a) Provide food services for the homeless
- (b) Provide funding for CHARLES PERKINS MINISTRIES, INC. to help them carry out their mission.
- Section 2:

This Corporation shall receive, purchase and maintain funds of real and personal property, and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set for to use and apply the whole or any part, and otherwise contribute to the purposes of the Corporation as defined in Article Two, Section 1, Paragraphs (a) and (b) or to those organizations that qualify as tax exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

# ARTICLES III - POWERS

This Corporation is to have any and all powers to do any and all things necessary or expedient to carry out the purposes and objectives of this corporation, subject to these Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, and shall possess all rights, privileges and immunities and to enjoy all benefits granted corporations under the Laws of the State of Florida, but limited only to such powers that are in furtherance of tax exempt purposes.

#### ARTICLES IV - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE V - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principle office of this Corporation shall be located at 415 S. Wiggins Road, City of Plant City, County of Hillsborough, State of Florida, 33566 provided that the corporation shall have the power to conduct its business anywhere within or outside the State of Florida or the United States of America.

#### ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: The Corporation is to be organized upon a non-stock, certificate

of membership basis. Such memberships shall be non-redeemable,

non-transferable, and non-divided bearing.

Section 2: Any personal that subscribes to the purposes of this corporation is

eligible for membership upon approval by a majority vote of the

corporation at any regular meetings of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE VII - SUBSCRIBER

# ARTICLES VIII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1: The affairs of the Corporation shall be directed by a Board of

Directors numbering not less than one (1) nor more than ten (10) members. Each member of the Board of Directors shall be elected By the members of the Corporation as prescribed by the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS

## ARTICLE XIII - REGISTERED AGENT

## <u>ARTICLE XIV - DISSOLUTION</u>

Upon dissolution or other termination of the Corporation, no part of the property of the Corporation or any of the proceeds shall be distributed to or used for the benefit of any of the members of the Corporation, but such property and proceeds subject to the discharge of valid obligations of the Corporation and to the applicable provisions of the Non-Profit Corporation Law under Chapter 671, Florida Statutes, shall be distributed as directed as directed by the Board of Directors of the Corporation among one or more corporations or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or education purposes; no part of the net earnings of which shall be used to the benefit or any individual or member, and no substantial part of whose activities consist or carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation or which does not participate or intervene in any political campaign or the type which qualify for the federal income tax exemption under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954/
