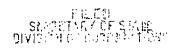

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

TAYLOR COUNTY RECOVERY CENTER, INC. (TCRC, Inc.)

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: any and all legal professional and personal services which help this nonprofit organization reach its goals. Taylor County Recovery Center, Inc. is a non-profit organization that provides out-patient substance abuse & drug treatment program providing individual and group counseling, substance abuse education, and relapse prevention support and programs. We delivers an array of programs and services that enable drug and alcohol free living, recovery success, reintegration, meaningful employment and independent living. Our primary goal is provide high quality services.

Taylor County Recovery Center, Inc., Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Taylor County Recovery Center, Inc. will engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, or which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational, counseling, referral and social services purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (i) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue laws.

ARTICLE IX. NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or: (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue laws.

X. Conflicts of Interest

For purposes of this provision, the term "interest" shall include personal interest, interest as director, officer, member, stockholder, shareholder, partner, manager, trustee or beneficiary of any concern and having an immediate family member who holds such an interest in any concern. The term "concern" shall mean any corporation, association, trust, partnership, limited liability entity, firm, person or other entity other than the organization.

No director or officer of the organization shall be disqualified from holding any office in the organization by reason of any interest in any concern. A director or officer of the organization shall not be disqualified from dealing, either as vendor, purchaser or otherwise, or contracting or entering into any other transaction with the organization or with any entity of which the organization is an affiliate.

ARTICLE XI. Non-Discriminatory Practices

Taylor County Recovery Center, Inc. (TCRC, Inc.), Inc. is committed to providing an inclusive and welcoming environment for all volunteers, staff, participates, groups, individuals, and agencies of the community and to ensuring that ministry, activities, educational and employment decisions are based on individuals, abilities and qualifications. Consistent with this principle and applicable laws, it is therefore our policy not to discriminate in offering access to our services, workshops, volunteer opportunities, educational programs and/or activities or with respect to employment terms and conditions on the basis of race, color, gender, national origin, age, religion, creed, disability, or veteran's status.

ARTICLE XII. DISSOLUTION

Upon the time of dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed by the Board of Directors, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs and expenses of the corporation, for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
