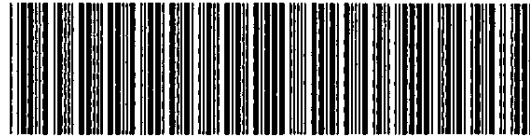

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation is **reCreate, Inc.**

ARTICLE II
Principal Office

ARTICLE III
Purpose

- A. The purpose for which this corporation is organized (but is not limited) to provide educational, career, and professional services to adults within the State of Florida.
- B. The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170©(2) of said Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future statute of the United States.






