ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEIGHBORHOOD VOICE, INC A Not for Profit organization

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Pursuant to the provisions of the statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation liability of ATE rights, priviledges, immunities, of a corporation not for profit. ARTICLE I - NAME

ARTICLE 111 - PURPOSE
