ARTICLE I ~ NAME

AfterLife Ministry Incorporated

ARTICLE III ~ PURPOSE

**AfterLife Ministry is a Native American (First Nations) Contextual Ministry.
The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:**

- 1. Organizing outreaches in poverty stricken communities nationwide by: providing food boxes, clothing and essentials, serving hot meals, providing a wide section of resources (literature, available programs, local churches, etc.), live music, and public speaking.**
- 2. Conducting Mission Work by: organizing and sending mission teams to First Nation communities across the nation, organizing and sending mission teams into communities across the nation, organizing and training mission teams to attend Native American events (Pow Wows, Native Circles, etc.), and to participate in certain First Nation traditions (dance, drum, circles, etc.).**
- 3. Public Speaking: organizing, training, and conducting public speaking sessions to bring words of encouragement and hope, with live music to: homeless shelters, churches, in jails and prisons, and any other venue which pertains to the vision of AfterLife Ministry.**
- 4. Jail Ministry: includes teaching, ministering, mentoring, public speaking and music engagements.**
- 5. Working with the homeless: Team ministry to the homeless in targeted areas where they live, attending and participating in homeless outreach events and programs.**
- 6. Partnering with other like-minded agencies and ministries to reach and minister to the less fortunate, the homeless, and the First Nation communities.**
- 7. Outreach facility (future vision), which will include but is not limited to: addiction recovery programs, addiction recovery groups, counseling in addiction recovery, housing for recovered addicts, food pantry and clothing closet, training facility, and emergency housing shelter.**

ARTICLE VIII ~ PURPOSED CLAUSE

AfterLife Ministry Incorporated is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE IX ~ DISSOLUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
