# **ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation is:

#### ALLIANCE CITOYENNE, INC.

# **ARTICLE II**

The term for which this corporation shall exist, shall be perpetual.

# **ARTICLE III**

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by said corporation shall be as follows:

To foster, support, and engage in activities relative to humanitarian relief, civil rights protection, civic engagement and civic participation by encouraging and protecting the right to vote in all parts of the globe, socioeconomic development, progress and ideals, including any and all activities which are lawful and appropriate in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. The organization shall engage in activities and programs that serve the Haitian communities in the **United States** and Haiti and elsewhere which serve to promote socioeconomic, civil rights, cultural and human development, mutual understanding, and public service in both countries and elsewhere.

That of engaging in any activity permitted under the laws of the United States of America, its territories, districts, and possessions, and any activity permitted under the laws of the State of Florida, and to have, exercise, and enjoy the powers and privileges granted to corporations not for profit by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, of the attainment of any of the objects, or for the furtherance of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business of powers, or any part thereof; provided, that the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

The purposes for which **ALLIANCE CITOYENNE**, **INC.** is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, social, economic, literary and educational political purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that

qualify as exempt organizations within the meaning of section 501 © (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

In pursuit of its goals, the organization shall establish the following objectives:

- 1) To promote civil rights in the United States, Haiti and other regions of the globe;
- 2) To encourage participation at all levels of government;
- 3) To promote socioeconomic and political development in the United States, Haiti and other regions of the globe;
- 4) To organize activities which serve to promote democratic institutions in Haiti and elsewhere;
- 5) To seek and secure funds to implement programs based on democratic ideals;

#### **ARTICLE IV**

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 <sup>®</sup> (4) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 <sup>®</sup> (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### **ARTICLE V**

Directors shall qualify for admission, and shall be admitted as board members, in accordance with the by-laws of this corporation. A two-thirds vote of the board members shall be required for the election of new directors or for the removal of current directors. Annually, during the month of December, the membership shall elect, from among those nominees previously approved by the **Executive Committee** of the Board, those members receiving the highest number of votes as there are vacancies.


