ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FIRST COAST FOUNDATION FOR SENIORS, INC.

A Florida "Not for Profit" Corporation



In compliance with the laws of the State of Florida, the undersigned do hereby voluntarily associate for the purpose of forming a Corporation not-for-profit for the purposes and with powers set forth herein.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The name of the corporation is **FIRST COAST FOUNDATION FOR SENIORS, INC.** The principal Office of the Corporation shall be located at **115 South Third Street, Jacksonville Beach, Florida 32250**, but the Corporation may maintain offices and transact business in such places, within or without the State of Florida, as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Directors. The principal office shall also be the mailing and registered office address.

ARTICLE !! – TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration is perpetual. The Corporation is organized pursuant to the not-for-Profit Corporation laws of the State of Florida. The date on which corporate existence shall be is the date on which these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III -- PURPOSE AND POWERS

The purposes of the Corporation shall be exclusively charitable, religious, educational, or scientific under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The organization will improve the quality of life for residents of Duval County by undertaking the following activities:

A. Provide assistance for services to qualified individuals who are residents of the subsidized housing properties managed by Elderly Housing Management Corporation. To date those properties include Pablo Towers and Pablo Hamlet, both are located in Duval County.

B. Provide services that enrich those residents' lives so that they can age in place with quality and dignity.

For such purposes, the Corporation shall have and exercise the following authority and powers:

- To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the State of Florida may now or hereafter have to exercise.
- To do all things necessary or desirable to accomplish the purposes of the Corporation as the Director of the Corporation may from time to time deem appropriate, which are consistent with powers conferred upon a not-forprofit Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida and the Internal Revenue Code.
- 3. To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use or otherwise deal in and with real personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

ARTICLE IV - POWERS - NO DISTRIBUTION OF GAIN

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation and any services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation. Nor shall the corporation carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and State income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code or corresponding section of any future tax code.

ARTICLE V - REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors of the Corporation shall not be less than three (3); provided however that the Board of Directors may, from time to time, increase or decrease the number of Directors, so long as the number of Directors does not exceed thirteen (13). The method of election of the Board of Directors shall be as stated in the bylaws. The names of the addresses of the initial Board of Directors are:

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ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS

ARTICLE VIII - BYLAWS

The Bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the first Board of Directors, which Bylaws may be altered, amended, modified or appealed in the manner set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE IX – AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any of the provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendments hereto. Notice setting forth the proposed amendment or a summary of the changes to be effected by the amendment must be given to each director in the same manner as notice for the meeting. Such amendment shall require the assent of a two-thirds majority vote of the directors present.



ARTICLE X - DISSOLUTION

The Corporation may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the directors. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code or shall be distributed for a public purpose to the federal government, a state or local government or to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. The Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is located, shall dispose of any assets not disposed of, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s) as said court shall determine is organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
