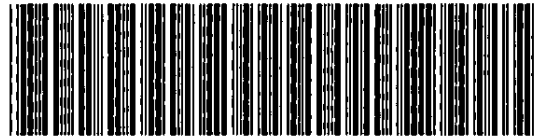





Article III – Purpose

The Frontline Project, Inc. (FLiP) – (Attachment)

Organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code. Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to the state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. The mission of The Frontline Project, Inc. (FLiP) is to address the social and systemic problems of our youth, family and community by operating as a catalyst for educational, economic empowerment and awareness through the wise and efficient use of the collective talents, training, skills, and the experiences of the members and other resources within the community and church. The Frontline Project, Inc. will be comprised of parents, clergy, civic and community leaders. The Frontline Project aims to be a force for positive change in the disenfranchised communities of our area by taking a positive nontraditional and unconventional approach toward the continuation of providing awareness and outlets for positive change.
