Article I - Name

1.01 Name

The name of the corporation shall be The New Music Conflagration, Inc.

Article IV - Purpose

4.01 Purpose

The New Music Conflagration, Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. The New Music Conflagration, Inc.'s purpose is to educate the public about new music in performance through a regular concert series open to the public; to advance new music education through an annual tuition-free festival for students from around the world; to combat community deterioration and juvenile delinquency by promoting cultural awareness and advancement through public workshops and community outreach events; and to eliminate prejudice and discrimination by chronicling the experiences of practitioners of new music in a curated online publication so as to display the commonalities between peoples of varying cultures and experiences worldwide.

#### 4.02 Public Benefit

The New Music Conflagration, Inc. is designated as a public benefit corporation.

#### Article V - Non-Profit Nature

# 5.01 Non-Profit Nature

The New Music Conflagration, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of The New Music Conflagration, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

The New Music Conflagration, Inc. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of the directors, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

5.02 Personal Liability

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of The New Music Conflagration, Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

#### 5.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the The New Music Conflagration, Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the The New Music Conflagration, Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the The New Music Conflagration, Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the The New Music Conflagration, Inc. by one or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

#### 5.04 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, properties of the directors of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV, Section 4.01.

#### 5.05 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

### 5.06 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (I) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.
