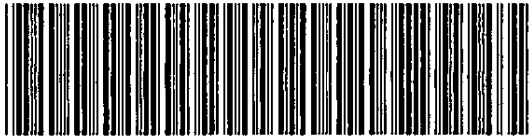

Articles of Incorporation
of

A Nonprofit Corporation

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act of this state, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1

The name of this corporation is Celandine Life-Prep Academy, Inc.

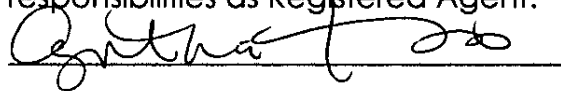

Article 3

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code

The specific objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be to provide lifelong academic education rich in sensory integration to promote whole body/whole mind development, and ongoing training and experience in pre-vocational/vocational skills, independent living skills, community interaction and involvement, and recreational pursuits for children grades 6 - 12 and ages 18-adulthood. In addition, this corporation shall provide on/off campus vocational opportunities, training, and experience for children grades 6 - 12 and ages 18-adulthood with sensory integrative dysfunction, autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities, learning disabilities, traumatic brain injury, and Down

syndrome and other chromosomal defects. This corporation shall solicit, collect, and otherwise raise money for charitable purposes: to expand, contribute, disburse, and other wise handle and dispose of the same for such purposes relating to the aims and goals of the educational development of children and young adults with sensory integrative dysfunction, autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities, learning disabilities, Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, and Down syndrome and other chromosomal defects. Included are contributions to institutions organized for the same or similar purposes; to assist in harmonizing and making more efficient the work of charitable organizations in the local community; all of which shall be within the meaning of section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 4

Directors/Officers are elected annually, by ballot .A regular meeting of members shall be held on the last Thursday in July, at 10 a.m., for the purpose of electing directors and transacting other business as may come before the meeting. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes up to the number of directors to be elected shall be elected. Each voting member shall cast one vote, with voting being by ballot only. The annual meeting of members for the purpose of electing directors shall be deemed a regular meeting.

Article 5

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered

to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

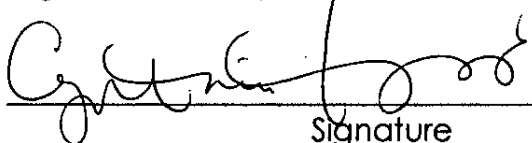

Article 7

Additional Provisions.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to special education purposes. Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundations, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for special education purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of, shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
