ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KORMERICA MISSION CENTER, INC. A Non-Profit Corporation

COMES NOW the undersigned incorporator, a citizen of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, does hereby certify the following:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation shall be Kormerica Mission Center, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Office

The principal office shall be located at 1025 S.W. Downs Blvd., Suite 202F, Palm City, Martin County, Florida 34990.

ARTICLE III Purpose

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV Manner of Election

ARTICLE VI Charitable Purposes

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII Dissolution of Assets

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
