ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE BERMAN FOUNDATION, INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes (Not for Profit)

Article I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is The Berman Foundation, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

Article II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is:

Article III PURPOSES

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is formed are as follows:

The Corporation is organized exclusively for, and will be operated exclusively for, the charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the current U.S. Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code ("Code"), including the charitable purpose of improving the quality of life for people and animals.

In furtherance of this purpose, the Corporation will provide information and/or grants to individuals that need assistance and organizations that support the Corporation's mission. In order to identify qualified individuals and organizations, the Corporation will perform independent (non-scientific) research, including reading traditional and targeted media sources (e.g. newspapers, magazines, Internet, television, not-for-profit news sources, word-of-mouth, etc.), and evaluate the needs of specific individuals, and the programs and projects of the organizations.

MANNER OF ELECTION

- A. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III (Purposes) hereof.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of

propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

- C. In accordance with Section 508(e) of the Code, if in any taxable year the Corporation is a private foundation as defined in Section 509(a) of the Code, then in such year, the Corporation:
 - (i) shall distribute such amounts for each taxable year at such time and in such mamer so as not to subject the Corporation to tax on undistributed income under Section 4942 of the Code;
 - (ii) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing (as defined under Section 4941(d) of the Code);
 - (iii) shall not retain any excess business holdings (as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code) which are subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4943 of the Code;
 - (iv) shall not make any investments in such manner so as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and
 - (v) shall not make any taxable expenditures (as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code).
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by:
 - A not for profit corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes;
 - (ii) A corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code; or
 - (iii) A corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

Article IX DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, after paying all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such

assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article X DURATION

The duration of the Corporation's existence shall be perpetual.

Article XI AMENDMENT

The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereto.

Article XII INTERNAL REVENUE CODE

All references herein to the Code are to the version of the Internal Revenue Code in effect as of the date hereof, and shall be deemed to include both amendments thereto and statutes which succeed the provisions thereof (i.e., the corresponding provisions of future United States Internal Revenue Laws).
