## RESTATED AND AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NATIONAL FARM LABOR CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1007, Florida Statutes, NATIONAL FARM LABOR CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida not for profit corporation originally incorporated under the name of NATIONAL FARM LABOR SAFETY ASSOCIATION, INC., whose original articles of incorporation were filed by the Florida Department of State on January 29, 1986, by unanimous consent and adoption without a meeting by its board of directors, hereby adopts the following restated and amended articles of incorporation:

### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation is NATIONAL FARM LABOR CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC. [Amended 12/3/91].

## ARTICLE II - CORPORATE PURPOSE

The object and purpose of the Corporation shall be to reduce and eliminate business-related accidents, injuries and losses, and the causes thereof, and to insure and promote the safety of persons who labor on farms and the safety of farm property and to create, promote, conduct, coordinate, and effect among its members a program designed to identify, reduce and eliminate business-related accidents, injuries, losses and their causes.

### ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

<u>Section 1:</u> Eligibility. Any person shall be eligible for membership in this corporation upon application to and approval as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

Section 2: Application for Membership. Any applicant

meeting the qualifications set forth above and desiring to become a member of the Corporation shall make application on a form supplied by the Corporation and accompanied by such membership fees and dues as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

<u>Section 3: Termination of Membership</u>. Membership may be terminated by expulsion for a just cause or by resignation with thirty days prior written notice to the Board of Directors.

<u>Section 4:</u> Excepting for members who are also Directors of the Association, members have no voting or other rights. [Amended 12/3/91].

#### ARTICLE IV - DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

## ARTICLE V - MANAGEMENT

<u>Section 1</u>. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three and not more than five persons. Directors shall be elected or removed in accordance with the procedure provided by the Bylaws.

<u>Section 2</u>. The officers of the Corporation shall be a President, one or more Vice Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer. These officers shall be elected and shall hold office in the manner provided in by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer, director or employee of the Corporation, or any former officer, director or employee of the Corporation, to the full extent permitted by and as set forth in Florida Statutes Chapter 607 and 617. [Amended 7/8/97].

### ARTICLE XIII - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution, assets of the corporation, to the extent allowed by the laws of the State of Florida, shall be distributed to members in the amount and manner determined by the Board of Directors. [Amended 7/8/97].

The foregoing restated articles of incorporation primarily restate and integrate the provisions of the corporation's articles of incorporation as previously amended, and also contain certain amendments, specifically designated as "Amended," which were adopted pursuant to Section 617.1002, Florida Statutes. There is no discrepancy between the corporation's articles of incorporation as previously amended and the provisions of these restated articles of incorporation other than the inclusion of amendments adopted pursuant to Section 617.1002, Florida Statutes, and the omission of matters of historical interest.
