ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FISHER ISLAND COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.

- 1. The Articles of Incorporation of Fisher Island Community Association, Inc., a Florida corporation not-for-profit (the "Association"), created pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes were filed on March 4, 1986 and assigned Florida document number N13676.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statues, the Association adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.
- 3. All other provisions of Declaration not otherwise amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. Those portions of the Declaration that are being deleted by these amendments are represented hereinabove as stricken (e.g., stricken out) and portions of the Declaration that are being added by these amendments are represented hereinabove as underlined (e.g., underlined).
- 5. Section 6(B)(1) of Article V of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended as follows:

Section 6. Resident Director Election Procedures

- (B) The Election of Resident Directors shall be conducted in the following manner:
- (1) First Notice and Nominations. The Association will mail, deliver or electronically transmit a first notice of the election to all Voting Members at least sixty (60) days before a scheduled election. Voting Members must submit written nominations for Resident Directors to the President/Chief Executive Officer of the Association not less than (40) days prior to the election. Nominations for Resident Directors shall also be made by Nominating Committee: A Nominating-Committee-composed of-five (5) Individuals may be appointed by the Board of Directors at a duly called meeting held no more that ninety (90) days and not less than sixty (60) days prior to each Annual Meeting of the Voting Members or election of Resident Directors and the Nominating Committee shall serve for a term-of one (1) year or until their successors are appointed by the Board of Directors. The Nominating Committee shall consist of a Chairman, who shall be a Resident Director that is not up for re-election, two-(2) Voting Members of the Association; one (1) director of the Club and one (1) officer of the Association. The Nominating Committee shall recommend, at least thirty five (35) days prior to the Annual Meeting of the Voting Members or election of Resident Directors, the names of the nominees and/or candidates supported by at least a majority vote of the Nominating Committee.



The Nominating Committee shall make as many nominations for election to the Board of Directors as it shall in its discretion determine, but not less than the number of vacancies that are to be filled.

6. Pursuant to Article VIII of the Articles of Incorporation and Section 617.1002, Florida Statutes, the foregoing amendment to Section 6 (B)(1) of Article V of the Articles of Incorporation was proposed and approved by a majority of board members at a duly noticed meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 17, 2012.u
