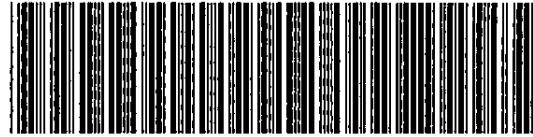

**Articles of Incorporation
Of

(In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., Not for Profit)**

Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Cornerstone Community Center, Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at: 1808 James L. Redman Pkwy, #187, Plant City, FL 33563. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Timothy Reaves.

Article 3.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.




