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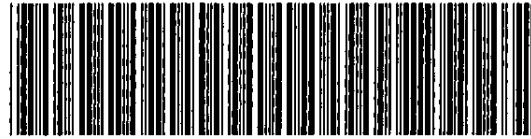





Articles of Incorporation Addendum: Joshua 19 Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized to:

- *support youth athletics*
- *help fund juvenile cancer treatment and research; support families with juveniles receiving cancer treatment*
- *support Marine Corps organizations, including JROTC programs and support of Marine Corps families with demonstrated need*
- *fund Christian schools and Christian education programs for all ages including needs related to supplies, building funds, or resources necessary for Christian education.*

Said foundation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the foundation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Statement of Purpose hereof. The property of this foundation is irrevocably dedicated to the 501(c)(3) exempt purposes outlined above and no part of the net income or assets of this foundation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

No substantial part of the activities of the foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this foundation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this foundation.

Upon the dissolution of the foundation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed:

The management of the affairs of the foundation shall be vested in a board of directors, as defined by the foundation's bylaws. No director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the foundation.

Members of the initial board of directors shall serve until the first annual meeting, at which their successors will be duly elected and qualified, or removed as provided in the bylaws.

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
