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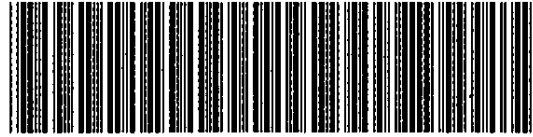

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF**

The Hispanic Young Professional of Jacksonville, Inc.

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DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS
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The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a non-profit Corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

Article 1-Name

The name of the Corporation is **Hispanic Young Professionals of Jacksonville, Inc.** (hereinafter "Corporation").

Article 2-Purpose

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including but not limited to making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 3-Prohibitions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to the directors or officers, members or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 2. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 4-Principal Office

The address of the principal office of the Corporation is 301 W. Bay Street, Suite 1426, Jacksonville, Florida, 32202, and the mailing address for the Corporation is the same.

Article 5-Election of Directors

The manner in which directors are elected shall be as set forth in the Corporation's bylaws.

Article 7-Incorporator

Article 8-Officers

The Corporation shall elect officers as set forth in the bylaws.

Article 9-Members

The Corporation may have members as set forth in the bylaws but shall not issue membership certificates. The Corporation shall not issue shares of stock.

Article 10-Registered Office and Agent

The initial registered address of the registered office of the Corporation is located at 301 W. Bay Street, Suite 1426, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. The name of the registered agent of the Corporation is Miguel Rosada Jr., 301 W. Bay Street, Suite 1426, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.

Article 11-Amendment

Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the directors then in office. Members shall not be entitled to vote on amendments to the Articles of Incorporation.

Article 12-Liability for Debts

The directors, officers, or members of the Corporation shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

Article 13-Indemnification and Civil Liability Immunity

The Corporation shall indemnify each director and officer, including former directors and officers, to the fullest extent allowed by law, including but not limited to Florida Statutes Chapter 617. It is intended that the Corporation be an organization the officers and directors of which are immune from civil liability to the extent provide by Florida Statutes 617 and other similar law.

Article 14-Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 15-Effective Date

These Articles of Incorporation shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

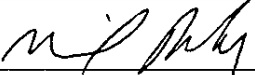
