The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: The corporate is a nonprofit public benefit cooperation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The cooperation is organization under the nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes, religious, and educational purposes. The making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (C) 3 of the internal Revenue Code. The programs will consist of, but shall not be limited to: disable persons services, Job Placement and training, Teenage Pregnancy, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, HIV/AIDS, Elderly Care and other programs to aid those in need.

- Four: The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, stock and shall have other members.
- Five: See officers on state form
- Six:
- (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Religious, Charitable, Educational, and/or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Seven: On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for, Religious, Charitable and Education under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
