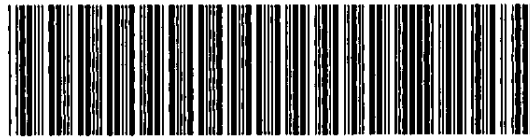

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

**ARTICLE I NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be:  
Men of Travail International Outreach Inc.

**ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

**ARTICLE III PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

To preach and teach the gospel of Jesus Christ building on a biblical foundation that will effectively enhance the lives of men, women and children, in spite of their race, creed or class. To provide transitional housing for men who are homeless or transitioning out of prison. This program will implement components such as job readiness, group counseling and other empowerment components necessary for them to stay on a righteous path. To provide programs that will aid the needs of senior citizens. To develop a food pantry that will meet the nutritional need of individuals and families who are in need of food. To implement programs that will be a safe haven for youth, and empower them with the necessary tools that are needed for them to become economically self-reliant. To implement a business development program that will assist those who have a desire to start their own business. To operate a multi-purpose movement that will effectively serve the community at large.

**ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION**

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## ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution and winding up of the organization after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non profit fund, foundation, association, or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and which has established its tax-exempt status under that section or corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or shall be distributed to federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, and which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

## ARTICLE IX- LIMITATIONS

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said code section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.


No part of the net earnings of the corporation or organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers of other private persons, except that the corporation or organization shall be authorized and empowered. To pay reasonable compensation for services tendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c) 3 purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation or organization shall commit the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting the influence legislation, and the corporation or organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to any candidate for public office.


Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation or organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by a corporation or organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation or organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the internal revenue code (or Corresponding section of any future federal tax code).
