
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

We the Undersigned personal of state Florida all of whom are of legal age, each being competent to contract, hereby from ourselves and our successor into a corporation not for profit under the Law of the State of Florida, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be: M.R.A. CASA DE PAN, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 4518 Curry Ford Rd. Orlando, FL 32812 Country of Orange, State Florida.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

- (h) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the organization is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501 (c) (3) of the internal Revenue code of 1986, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under IRC 501 (c) (3) o corresponding provision of any subsequent tax laws
- (i) No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be based on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provident by IRS 501 (h). or participating in or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

(j) In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the organization shall after the payment of necessary expenses thereof be distributed to such other organization as shall qualify under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986or Corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Law, or to the Federal Government, or State or Local Government for public purpose subject to the approval of a justice of the Supreme Court of State Florida.

ARTICLE IV POWERS

M.R.A. CASA DE PAN, INC. will and exercised all the rights and powers conferred on corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, provided that this corporation has no authority to engage in any activity other than to advance objects and purposes set forth in Article III

ARTICLE V NO FINANCIAL PROFIT OR MONETARY GAIN

is not organized, or be operated for profit or pecuniary gain, and includes the distribution of goods, or dividends to members, as this organization are formed non-profit. The property, assets, and net earnings of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to religious, scientific and charitable and any gain or net inflow of this corporation shall be to the advantage or benefit of any director, officer, and member or for the benefit of private shareholders or individuals. With the dissolution or closing liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific or which has established its tax exempt status under Section 23701 (d) of the Code of Internal Taxes. If this corporation has any assets in deposits, such property shall be distributed according to the decrees of the Superior Court of the County within which the principal office of this corporation is located, at the request for that at the attorney general or by any person interested in the settlement.
