Freedom for Humanity is a charity dedicated to providing the basic necessities of life at no cost, so that humanity can be free to explore the depths of Life, hove, and Spirituality, while also contributing to the increased quality of life in your community. This is not a system of simply giving to the poor and creating dependent people, this is a system of teaching people how to share resources and work together for the common good of all humanity; regardless of race, religion and title.
