

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 14 JUN 23 PM 4: 32

A Not For Profit Corporation TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Forest Hill Cemetery Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II
EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this corporation shall be the date of filing these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The street address of the initial principal office is 16625 SE 115th Avenue, Weirsdale, Florida 32195. The mailing address of the corporation is the same.

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSE

The purpose of the corporation is to own and operate a cemetery exclusively for the benefit of lot owners who hold such lots for the purpose of proper disposal of bodies by burial or cremation. The corporation will not engage in any business not necessarily incident to this purpose and no part of any net earnings of the corporation will inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.

ARTICLE V
BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of at least three persons, who shall be selected in the manner set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE VI
INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation and the name of the initial registered agent at that address are: 16625 SE 115th Avenue, Weirsdale, Florida 32195; Registered Agent: Harold B. Peters.

**ARTICLE VII
INCORPORATOR**

The name and address of the incorporator is: Harold B. Peters, 16625 SE 115th Avenue, Weirsdale, Florida 32195.


**ARTICLE VIII


