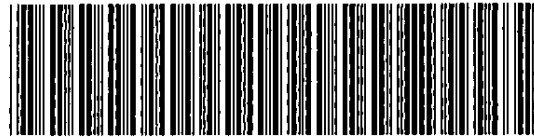

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation shall be CareerSource Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Address

The street address of the place of business of the Corporation is 1580 Waldo  
Palmer Lane, Tallahassee, FL 32308.

ARTICLE III

Term

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Purpose

The specific and primary purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

- a) The Corporation is organized for the benefit of the state, and is the principal  
workforce policy organization for the State of Florida.
- b) The Corporation is to design and implement strategies that help Floridians  
enter, remain in, and advance in the workplace, becoming more highly skilled

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and successful, benefiting Floridians, Florida businesses, and the entire state, and assisting in developing the state's business climate.

- c) The activities listed above will be carried out in accordance with Fla. Stat. §445.004, (and future amendments as approved by both the Florida Legislature and Governor), consistent with Pub. L. No. 105-220, Title I, s. 111(b), (and future amendments and/or federal legislation pertaining to workforce training) and within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE V

##### Board of Directors and Membership

The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be established in accordance with Fla. Stat. §445.004, (and future amendments) and shall be consistent with Pub. L. No. 105-220, Title I, s. 111(b), with the number of directors being determined by the Governor and applicable statutes.

#### ARTICLE VI

##### Powers of the Board of Directors

The Corporation shall develop Bylaws consistent with these Articles, and shall establish responsibilities of the Board of Directors and establish the operating policies and procedures of CareerSource Florida, Inc. The Board of Directors, by a majority vote, shall also have the power to make, alter or rescind any Bylaws on behalf of the Corporation.

## ARTICLE VII

### Amendment

These Articles may be altered, amended or repealed by resolution of the Board of Directors, subject to the limitations of Fla. Stat. §445.004.

## ARTICLE VIII

### Limitation of Corporate Powers

The corporate powers of CareerSource Florida, Inc. are as provided in Fla. Stat. §445.004.

## ARTICLE IX

### Indemnification

Except to the extent expressly prohibited by state or federal law, the Corporation shall defend, hold harmless and indemnify its board members and affiliated organizations, the State of Florida, and the United States Government for and from any and all claims, liabilities, losses, costs and expenses (including attorney's fees, costs and expenses), arising as a result of claims brought by any party for property loss or damage, personal injury or bodily injury, including death, arising in any manner or in connection with any of the Corporation's activities. Such indemnification shall extend to any claim for indirect, special, incidental or consequential damages or other loss of revenue or business injury or loss resulting from any loss of or damage to any property. If such injury or damage is proven to be directly caused by one of the foregoing indemnified organizations, then the Member may pursue necessary legal recourse from that organization.

## ARTICLE X

### Dissolution

In the event of the voluntary or involuntary liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, no member shall be entitled as such to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source after payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation, shall be distributed to the State of Florida with the intendment of Internal Revenue Code §501(c)(3) and the Regulations thereunder.


