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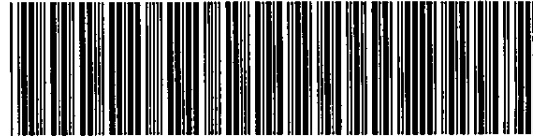

- f. To develop students' gifts in athletic programs.
- g. To build and structure a strong single school culture based on the ethics derived from the word of God.
- h. To use data to make informed decisions, instruction, professional learning, performance, and student learning.
- i. To develop the staff's capacity to collaborate effectively about instruction.
- j. To maintain appropriate records related to student attendance, instructional and non-instructional school personnel, and ensure the accuracy and timeliness of all school reports.
- k. To coordinate community activities relevant to the school.
- l. To hire teachers with deep content knowledge, competent in pedagogy, and understand how to teach the content to diverse populations with diverse learning styles. Teachers

should also provide mentoring to new staff members to bring them up-to-date with other staff to prevent gaps in student learning.

ARTICLE IV (amend)

Election:

The directors of the Corporation shall be elected in accordance with methods and qualifications specified in the bylaws of the Corporation. In no event, shall the number of directors be fewer than three.

Powers:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII (add)

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
