

### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

## WAKULLA SPRINGS LODGE STEWARDRY, INC.

The undersigned incorporate this Florida not-for-profit corporation and resolve as follows:

### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Wakulla Springs Lodge Stewardry, Inc.

# ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and its mailing address of this Corporation shall be: 1471 Timberlane Road - Suite 126, Tallahassee, Florida 32312; or, such other location as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time.

# ARTICLE III PURPOSES OF THE CORPORATION

This corporation is organized exclusively for educational and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. More particularly, the Corporation is organized are: (1) to educate and develop ways and means to attract the public to stay, study and enjoy the natural wonders that can be found at Wakulla Springs, a nationally and internationally renowned spring; (2) to work to educate the public as to the historic nature of the property and the importance of preserving the wildlife and natural features of the surrounding area; (3) to preserve and maintain the historic Wakulla Springs Lodge which is registered on the National Register of Historic Places and therein described as one of the largest and deepest springs in Florida, an independent freshwater ecosystem rich in aquatic vegetation, fish, turtles, alligators and birds with huge cypress trees and containing a well-developed hardwood hammock containing significant fossil evidence; (4) to work to preserve the Wakulla Springs Archeological and Historic District in the Edward Ball Wakulla Springs State Park within which the Wakulla Springs Lodge is located; (5) to develop an Edward Ball Museum on site as a tribute to the visionary entrepreneur; and (6) to do every other lawful act or acts, thing or things, incidental and pertaining to or growing out of or connected with the aforementioned purposes or any part or parts thereof.

### ARTICLE IV BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The lawful authority and powers of this Corporation shall be exercised by, and its business shall be conducted and carried on by, or be authorized to be conducted and carried on by, a Board of not less than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) Directors. The initial officers of the Board shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman, and a Secretary. The Board shall have the authority to

appoint an Executive Committee and to delegate any of its powers to the Executive Committee which shall exercise said powers subject to the supervision of the full Board. Only members of the Board shall have voting rights. The members of the Board shall be elected in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the initial members of the Board who shall serve until the first election are as follows:

### ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

Per Section §617.0601(1)(a), Florida Statutes, this corporation shall have no members.

# ARTICLE VI EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OFFICES AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The Board of Directors shall have the authority to employ an Executive Director and one or more officers and employees and to manage the affairs of the Corporation subject to the supervision of the Board. The Board of Directors shall engage such professional services as it deems necessary and proper, but shall engage a non-board member individual or firm as general counsel to the Corporation and a non-board member individual or firm as a certified or chartered public accountant to the Corporation. Such Executive Director and other officers and employees shall be compensated as provided by the Board of Directors.

# ARTICLE VII CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of this Corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited by the by-laws of the Corporation adopted pursuant hereto.

# ARTICLE VIII VACANCIES

Vacancies occurring on the Board of Directors or corporate offices shall be filled in such manner and at such time and under such conditions as may be set out in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE IX BY-LAWS

The initial By-Laws of this Corporation shall be as adopted by the initial Directors set forth in Article V above. Thereafter, the By-Laws of this Corporation shall be altered, amended or rescinded only by two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors at a regularly called meeting,

or at any other meeting of said Board members called for the purpose, provided, however, that in case a meeting is called for this purpose, it shall be called strictly in accordance with the existing By-Laws of the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE X

### INITIAL INCORPORATOR, REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

William Crona is an incorporator of the Corporation and shall serve as its initial registered agent and the address of the initial registered office is 1471 Timberlane Road – Suite 126, Tallahassee, Florida 32312.

#### ARTICLE XI

#### **AMENDMENTS**

These Articles may be amended by two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors present and voting at any regular or special meeting called pursuant to the By-Laws of the Corporation for the purpose of amending the Articles.

#### ARTICLE XII

#### DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state or local government for a public purpose.
