Non-Profit Articles of Incorporation Of Early Education Link, Inc.

The undersigned, incorporator, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, Chapter of the Florida Statutes hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I: Name of Corporation

The name of the non-profit corporation is Early Education Link, Inc. to as the "Corporation".

Article II: Principal Office and Mailing Address

The address of the principal office is 19811 NW 7th Ave Miami, Florida 33169 and the mailing address is 16951 NW 4th Avenue, North Miami Beach, Florida 33169.

Article III. Purpose of the Corporation

The primary purpose of this organization is exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

This is a non-profit charitable organization formed for the purpose of establishing and operating programs that are geared toward the empowerment of youth and families through linking community based organizations together by education.

We will perform in compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.
